This week we have seen some lovely work coming from the classes as they settle into the daily routines. The children are showing such positive attitudes on their return to school and are displaying good behaviour for learning which is so important for their concentration levels.

Our leadership team met this week to discuss events for the children for the rest of the year given that we now have an increase in numbers and age range.
