It has been another busy week and there is such a spread of learning going on across school at the moment I wanted to share some of the highlights that I have seen since the start of the term:

Blossom: thoroughly settled and playing together to visit 'Dinosaur World' - creative play at its best!

Berries: some fabulous acting out of the story of The Gruffalo - children sitting and listening attentively and engaging with their learning. Keen and happy to share what they are doing.

Reception: high levels of engagement and enjoyment in their activities and opportunities for independent writing which the children were responding enthusiastically too.

Year 1: comparing numbers in maths and challenging themselves within the lesson. Really good levels of learning seen.

Year 2: children were engaged in discussing their ideas with Talk Partners to support them in writing their stories whilst focusing on the sequencing of events. The children very much like the story they have been reading.

Year 3: have been engaging with a unit on Poetry and have been learning to recite poems as well as use them to create their own verses or poems - such different styles and lots of great rhyming words!

Year 4: have been continuing to learn their times tables to help them with fluency and speed whilst answering random questions.

Year 5: beginning to learn the art of using a compass for drawing the perfect circle - not an easy task whether you move the compass or just the paper!

Year 6: challenging work on fractions this week which is encouraging discussion and use of prior knowledge and understanding.
